All-Star Bulletin # 1

Welcome to the 2019 All-Star Games!

You have been selected to play in one of the most prestigious events for North Carolina high school athletes. We try to select the best players in each sport and also students of good character. We congratulate you on your selection and are looking forward to your participation in our All-Star activities in Greensboro this summer.

Because of the many plans required to make the All-Star experience in Greensboro as memorable as possible, we *must* be notified immediately if you cannot play and will have to be replaced. Please save everyone embarrassment by letting us know promptly if you fail to graduate from high school, cannot be released from summer school, or have been indicted or convicted of a felony offense. For any of these reasons, you cause yourself to be ineligible to play in the East-West All-Star Game.

You and your high school coach need to get together to make sure you'll be bringing the proper equipment. College-issued equipment is not allowed by us or by the NCAA. Your high school coach can also be helpful with transportation needs. Football players will receive an equipment checklist in a later text.

If you haven't already done so, we need you to submit a **good quality head and shoulders photo** of yourself to be used for your biography in our *All-Star Games Program and Yearbook* to eastwestprogram@gmail.com. This is a professionally prepared publication that we think you and your family will want to keep as a reminder of your All-Star experience.

You will need to have 2 documents on file with us before being permitted to play: **(1)** a physical exam that is current on the date of your All-Star game -a copy of your high school physical (if still valid at game time) or a copy of a recent physical for college or employment are acceptable, **(2)** the Concussion Statement with appropriate signatures. If you haven't already done so, please mail, fax, or email these to us now.

We provide housing, meals, and transportation while you are with us for practice and your game. You and your teammates will be staying at a local hotel and details about your housing location will be included in a later bulletin.

The All-Star Games will be played on these dates:

Basketball	Monday, July 15	6:30 p.m.-Women's Game, followed by Men's Game (Greensboro Coliseum)
Soccer	Tuesday, July 16	6:30 p.m.- Women's Game, 8:30 p.m -Men's Game (MacPherson Soccer Stadium)
Football	Wednesday, July 17	8:00 p.m. (Jamieson Stadium, Greensboro, NC)

If you indicated to us that you would not be attending summer school and later find that you will be, you need to talk to your college athletic academic advisor immediately. This is necessary so you can arrange to be available for all our activities. If you have to miss more than one practice, you cannot participate in the All-Star game. Let us know immediately if you won't be able to participate.

Please take care of these items so all our lives will be easier. We look forward to seeing you in July.
