RULES for PLAYERS Participating in the EAST-WEST ALL-STAR GAMES

ALL-STAR ATHLETES CHECKLIST

The following items are your responsibility for your All-Star trip to Greensboro:

- Transportation. (Check with your high school coach if you need assistance. He/she is to make sure your travel arrangements are made.)
- Practice gear and shoes, shorts, helmet, pads, undergarments, tee shirts
- Personal toilet articles. (Linens, towels, soap, and shampoo are provided.)
- Casual clothing for recreation, swimming, and leisure time.
(No short shorts or tank tops when appearing in public.)
- "Dress clothes" - For the All-Star Banquet, men will need dress shoes and a coat and tie or, at least, a dress shirt and tie; women will need "Sunday dress" and appropriate shoes. Basketball and football players will also need to wear dress clothes for a religious service on Sunday morning
- Spending money -- You will not need much because we'll keep you busy. You may need money for long distance phone calls if you don't bring a cell phone.
